PROGRAMS FOR 2024

2024 Initiatives

Each initiative focuses on community engagement, empowerment, and support, reflecting our Foundation's commitment to creating positive change in our communities.

Expand Thrift & Fund Social Venture

Objective: To provide work experience and engagement opportunities.

Action Plan: Employ 25 paid staff and engage 250 volunteers throughout the year.

Focus: Enhance vocational skills and offer real-world work experience in a thriving thrift store environment.



Empower Home Program

Objective: To end homelessness through personalized support.

Action Plan: Develop and implement a robust volunteer program.

Focus: Provide friendship, connection, and a compassionate listening ear to unhoused individuals.

The program aims to understand each individual's unique needs and aspirations, while empowering volunteers, outreach workers and peer supporters with the skills to assist in their transition to stable housing.



Community Empowerment Through Peer Assistance (CETPA) Initiative



Objective: To facilitate meaningful connections and support for homeless individuals through peers with lived experience, aiding their journey towards stability and secure housing.

Action Plan: Hire and train 10 peer support workers.

Focus: Develop a robust training program for peer support, ensuring trained individuals are ready to offer effective and empathetic assistance.

Facilitate Community Forum on Policing Legislation

Objective: To involve the community in shaping policing policies.

Action Plan: Organize a community forum.

Focus: Gather community insights and opinions to form a community-focused approach to law enforcement, emphasizing the importance of community voices in legislative processes.



Expand CARE & Tri Cities Community Hub



Objective: To address and tackle the root causes of food insecurity.

Action Plan: Continue serving 200 people weekly and collaborate with local organizations for increased support.

Focus: Offer friendship through trained volunteers, meeting with participants weekly to address the root cause of food insecurity. This expansion includes the ongoing development of the Tri-Cities Community Hub for collaborative work among local organizations.
